

RESEARCH QUESTIONS AND HYPOTESES



RQ1: How can AI be used for corporation management at the board of directors level?



H1: There are three probable ways for the use of AI for corporation management at the board of directors' level: (a) AI as a Board Member (b) Limited Delegation of Management Rights to AI (c) Utilization of 'Assistant' AI for Decision-making Procedures in Corporation Management.

RESEARCH QUESTIONS AND HYPOTESES



RQ 2: What would be the legal consequences of the use of AI in and by the board of directors in terms of the board's structure and liability layout?



H2: Each of the three probable ways of use of AI for corporation management at the board of directors' level requires revision of current formation rules for the board of directors in terms of its conduct and directors' liability layout.
